There is no greater thrill than sneaking up on a tailing redfish and presenting the perfect cast and "fish on "! He also fishes the same surrounding areas for the elusive snook; this fish is the ultimate tackle tester. An excellent fighter, he'll test your skill as angler and fight like a largemouth Bass on steroids. Sea trout also prowl these same lush grass flats, ready and willing to slam any thing that makes a commotion on the top of the water, be it plug or fly. Not far offshore, Permit, Cobia, and tripletail [buoy fish] inhabit the trap lines. These fish are

all excellent adversaries on either light tackle or a fly rod. And we can't forget the Silver King [The Tarpon]. These fish abound here in the early spring to mid-summer. The only thing more exciting than stalking fish on the flats is stalking fish that are 7 plus feet in length and weighing up to 225 lbs.

Capt. Bo fishes these monsters on the beaches, in the passes, and on the flats. Here on the flats these fish can be found in less than 2 feet of water. Laid up in potholes as they float like silvery logs, motionless until the fly reaches his peripheral vision. He turns.. he's on it.. strip, strip, strip, Before you know it, he's into the backing and jumping like a lightning bolt from below! This is the ultimate angling rush! These fish put on one of the best aerial shows that there is to be seen.



Captain Bo is also quickly developing a reputation as one of the Nation's Top Shark Fishing guides, catching several species of Shark on light tackle in South Florid a. After dramatic success in the Madfin Series on TV, Captain Bo has been guiding such celebrities as Kevin Van Dam to a fantastic experience on the end of the fishing rod. 

Sharkin'



When people think of sharks, they picture "JAWS". When WE picture sharks, we picture you with a trophy of a lifetime!

Sharks are one of the few species that have not changed much from the prehistoric days. We give everyone the opportunity to go to battle against these "top of the food chain" predators! You can target the Great Hammerhead shark (a fish that weighs over 1,000 pounds), the man eating Bull shark, the Lemon shark, and the acrobatic Black Tip Shark.

Any of these sharks will give you a thrill of a lifetime! We fish in the shallow, pristine waters of Pine Island Sound near Ft. Myers, Sanibel Island, Captiva Island, and Boca Grande Pass.

Best Months: MAR-OCT

Tarpon the Silver King



The only thing more exciting than stalking fish on the flats is stalking fish that are 7 plus feet in length and weighing up to 225 lbs. Here on the flats these fish can be found in less than 3 feet of water.

Tarpon will start showing up anywhere from mid March to April, depending on the cold fronts. This is the time when thousands of fish make their way from the south as they come up to the spawning grounds, taking place mid May and June, both on new and full moons and during high tides. At these times, these fish can be caught by fly or the primary bait (pass crabs) that flush out on outgoing tide with the tarpon.

Ideal for all you avid anglers or the weekend warriors who want to wet a line and get away from the cold winter weather. Come and be kissed by the sunshine while fishing the warm, crystal clear Key West waters where we specialize in sharks, 'cudas, permit, and cobia in season. All sight fishin'!

Get your adrenaline pumpin' as a wolf pack of 'cudas charge your lure. And as he grey hounds outa the water and crashes down on your bait, the fight is on.. they jump, peel line at an amazing rate of speed, and will fight to the death.

After your 'cuda catchin', it's off to the nearby flats or wrecks to get the chum overboard. It usually doesn't take long 'til ya have plenty of hungry predators looking for an easy meal. As the first fin appears your heart will beat double time as he hones in on his target and you realize he is only feet from your bait, he stops, circles, tails up and a mud appears and SHARK ONNN!

Whatta rush!

We can't forget about the 'Brown Shark' of the flats and wrecks ~ the Cobia. These fish inhabit the nearby wrecks and can be found riding the backs of Rays and big sharks on the flats. These fish will surely give any angler a true test of their skills and spirit on light tackle. Bring your catch to the

local waterfront restaurant where they will cook it for you to enjoy some of the most delectable table fair you'll have tasted.

And last, but definitely not least, try your luck at the chance to catch the elegant Permit. These fish will fight to the death, like a giant jack on steroids. They can be caught on wrecks and also sight fished on the flats. We promise the first time you see the beautiful black "V" protruding from the surface, tailed up eating crustaceans, your heart will skip a few beats. When he eats, and you watch the line scream off the reel at an amazing speed, the skipped beats will move straight into a heart rate of someone that just ran a marathon!!!

Best Months: DEC – MAR, but can be enjoyed year-round.
